CPM MATH	<p>CPM Math will be used throughout the year. As in 6th grade math, every student will be issued a CPM ebook. The ebook has material for in and out of the class and includes embedded links, demonstrations, hints, and help. Students will be given a password to access the e-book from school and at home.</p>

IXL	<p>IXL is an online program that can strengthen skills and improve on topics aligned to the Ohio State Standards. Every week students will have an IXL assignment due. The assignment will be assigned on Monday and will be due Friday of that week BEFORE class. This weekly practice will count towards your grade.</p>
HOMEWORK	<p>Homework is a daily expectation. Success in 7th grade math relies heavily on completion of all assignments. Most homework assignments will utilize the CPM ebook, but homework may also consist of additional practice. Every homework assignment will be worth 1 point for completion. A half-point will be given for a homework assignment that is turned in one day late; no credit will be given after.</p>
ABSENTEEISM/ LATE WORK	<p>While you are absent, check the website and Google classroom for assignments so you can keep up with the class. See your teacher when you return to school.</p> <p>All assignments should be completed on time. Failure to do so may cause you to lose some points. Progress Book will show missing assignments due to absenteeism or being late.</p>

TEST RETAKE POLICY

All students may retake *Individual Tests* for *partial credit* if their grade is below an A. The maximum grade a student can earn on the Individual Test is a 90% A after a retake. Students need only to retake the missed questions from their original test. Retakes must be completed one week after an Individual Test is returned.
